
IN BRIEF

DESCRIPTION

The 26m² living room is complemented by a 10.5m² separate reading area, both with patio doors leading out to a private terrace, perfect for enjoying the outdoors. The 19.7m² dining room features wood flooring, doors to the patio, and a marble fireplace, creating a welcoming atmosphere. The kitchen retains many original features of the house, adding character and charm.

On the ground floor, you'll also find a second salon (28m²) with doors leading to the rear terrace, as well as a bedroom, office, shower room, and WC. The property has two front doors, offering the potential to divide the space for a smaller habitation or to be used as a commercial venture.

Upstairs, a beautiful staircase leads to 5 well-sized bedrooms, 2 of which have their own en-suite bathrooms. A family bathroom serves the remaining bedrooms. All bedrooms are generously sized, with high ceilings, adding to the sense of space.
