

DESCRIPTION

This is the perfect property for a couple or family. The energy consumption is relatively low with a B rating on the DPE. There are two downstairs bedrooms, one upstairs bedroom, a single garage and a utility room all under the same roof - no need to go outside.

There is underfloor heating on the ground floor, a pompe a chaleur and a wood burner.

The swimming pool has roman steps instead of a ladder, which facilitates access for children and people with limited mobility. There is also a terrace along the back of the house with plenty of space for BBQs in the warmer months.

There is a small front garden and a large back garden surrounded by trees and hedges. At the end of the garden, part of the land is constructible - perfect for a second house to rent or sell.

The kitchen is spacious, well-lit and well designed. The dining room is big enough to host guests and the living room is spacious too.

Each of the three bedrooms are large and have their own bathroom complete with a WC, bath or shower.
