


IN BRIEF

Outdoor Space & Garden

Set on a beautiful 948 m² plot, the property benefits from private off-road parking, an easily accessible garage, and a mature garden with trees and Mediterranean plants. The south-facing garden enjoys views of Mont Canigou, making it a perfect space to relax. At the heart of the outdoor area is an 11m x 5m swimming pool, complete with a surrounding terrace and a pool house.

Interior & Living Spaces

From the moment you step inside, the home's warm and inviting ambiance captivates.

- Ground Floor: The entrance hall leads to a rustic kitchen with a pantry area at the rear. The spacious and bright living area features a fireplace and French doors opening onto a stunning south-facing terrace, an ideal spot to take in the spectacular views of the pool and surrounding nature. A WC is also located on this level.
- First Floor: A mezzanine landing leads to a charming bedroom, a bathroom with WC, and a small box room, currently used as an occasional extra bedroom.
- Lower Level: Directly accessed from the living area, this private retreat includes the main bedroom with an en-suite shower room and WC, along with two adjoining rooms, ideal for storage and access to the garage.
