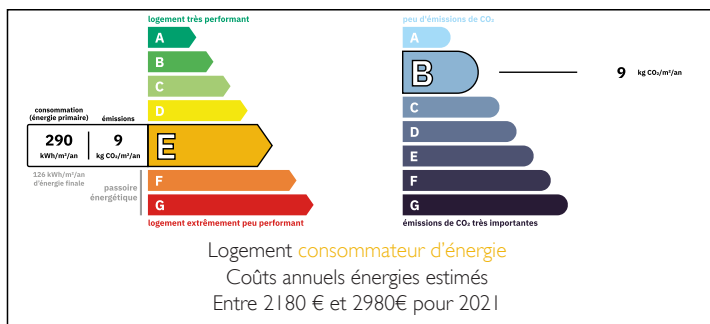
IN BRIEF

DESCRIPTION

As it was once part of the fortified sector of the village, the house has its back turned to the road and the front is hidden from view. From the road, enter the once-fortified enclosure via the double gates and through the covered entrance (room for parking if desired). Ahead, beyond the stone terrace, is a grassed area bordered with flowerbeds. To the right, the front of the house. White stone walls of 60 to 80 cm

Ground floor:

Open-plan living/dining room/kitchen, with huge open fireplace, terracotta 'tomette' floor tiles, windows and door to terrace

Door through to a lounge with large fireplace and door to a small room containing the ancient brick-lined bread oven and access to the road side of house

4 bedrooms

1 bathroom

1 shower room

1 separate WC

1 office space

50 m2 attic space with potential for conversion to living space in the central area
