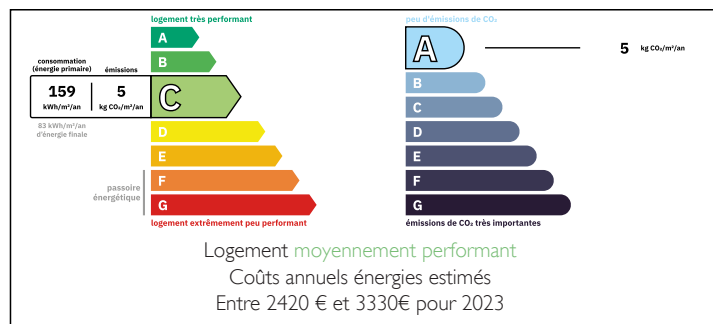

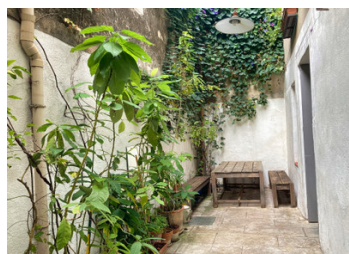

On the ground floor, you'll find a welcoming, well-equipped kitchen featuring a traditional range cooker and direct access to the courtyard – perfect for alfresco dining. A cosy sitting room with a wood-burning stove, a spacious dining room, and an ensuite bedroom complete the ground level.

The first floor offers three additional bedrooms, a home office, and a shower room, while the top floor is a real highlight – a stunning 48m² studio space with high ceilings and Velux windows, ideal as an artist's studio, additional living area, or master suite. This level also includes two further bedrooms and another shower room.

Throughout the property, original features have been beautifully preserved, including decorative cement tiles, ornate fireplaces, high ceilings, and vaulted cellars – all adding to the home's undeniable charm.

Montpeyroux is a vibrant village renowned for its wine, with several wineries, a bar, restaurants, a tabac, and essential local amenities. Ideally located just 40 km from the centre of Montpellier, 60 km from Béziers, and around 50 km from the Mediterranean coast, it offers the perfect balance of peaceful village life with easy access to the city and the sea.
