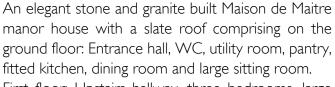

Large stone outbuilding in the grounds with gite potential. The house is situated in a tiny village with friendly in habitants, the residents of the village St Quentin.

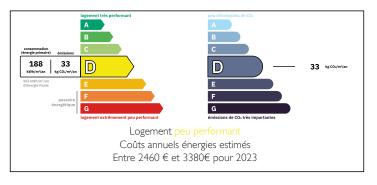
