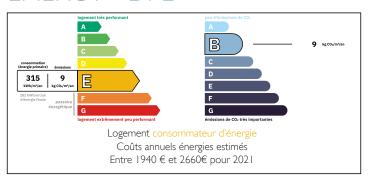

### DESCRIPTION

The property has a long, gravel drive which is accessed via a quiet country lane. As with many country homes, the kitchen is the heart of the home and this is definitely the case with this property. A large bright room with a large cooker range, a Rayburn, wood fired stove and fitted cupboards. There is room for a dining table and seating area. Wooden and stone floors. Stairs lead to the first floor where there is a wide landing, two bedrooms and a large shower room.

Stone steps from the kitchen lead down to the lounge which has vaulted ceiling, a huge fireplace with wood burner and other original features. Off this room is a family bathroom with bath, sink and WC. An ancient stone staircase leads to the third bedroom which also has a mezanine floor which could be used as an overflow bedroom or dressing room.

Outside there is a huge workshop behind the house and a stone building which with the appropriate permissions could be made into a gites but the current owners use it for storage. There is also a large open hanger and enclosed wood store.

One of the striking things about this property are the gardens and the views! It is the perfect place for any nature lovers, you can walk for miles straight from your front door.
