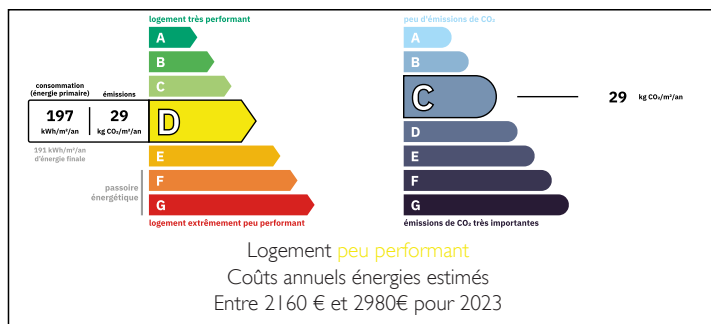
The property retains beautiful original features such as exposed beams, traditional tiling, and old stone walls.

Upstairs are a spacious office, three bedrooms (one en suite with shower), and a second bathroom and wc.

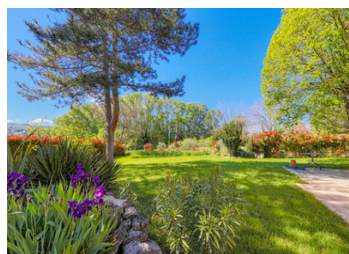
