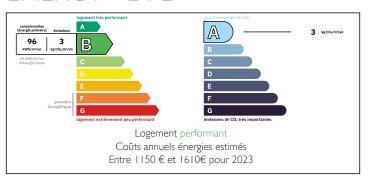




IN BRIEF

Set on 1.8 hectares of private land with woodland and meadows, the property includes a stone barn with office, an outbuilding with summer kitchen, carport, and more. A tranquil mill stream flows through the grounds, adding to the peaceful, bucolic atmosphere. With its authentic stone architecture and unspoiled setting, this is a rare opportunity to own a piece of French rural heritage—ideal as a permanent residence, luxurious retreat, or guest property.
