

Bordeaux Sud/Beautiran—19th-Century Riverside Maison de Maître – Landscaped Park, Pool, Outbuilding & Garage

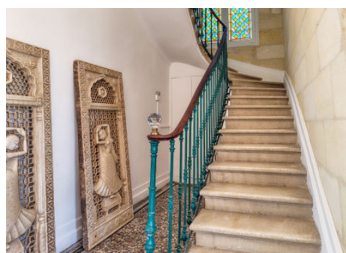

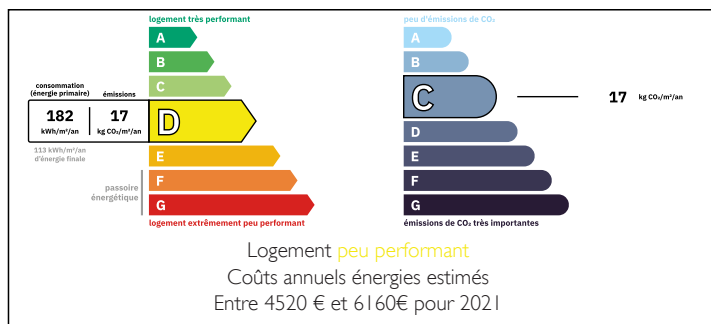

IN BRIEF

Nestled in a wooded park with completely unobstructed views of the Garonne river and elevated on the sizable garden-level cellar, this 19th century residence has been completely renovated while maintaining the traditional finishes of the time. A large entrance with cement tiles, beautiful high ceilings serving a double living room, dining room, library/lounge, and kitchen seduces you with generous volumes. Upstairs, 4 bedrooms each with its own bathroom complete this magnificent property. An outbuilding (partially renovated) offers an independent turnkey one-bedroom apartment with its own terrace above the garage.

DESCRIPTION

Set amidst a beautifully wooded park with panoramic, unobstructed views over the Garonne River, this exquisite 19th-century Maison de Maître has been meticulously restored to its original grandeur. Elevated on a vast garden-level cellar, the residence effortlessly blends timeless elegance with modern comforts.

A stately entrance hall adorned with original cement tiles welcomes you into the home, revealing soaring ceilings and a refined flow through grand reception rooms including a double living room, formal dining room, library/lounge, and a generous kitchen—each space radiating period charm and generous volumes.

The upper floors host four spacious bedrooms, each with its own en-suite bathroom, offering privacy and refined comfort for family and guests alike.

Enhancing the lifestyle appeal is a large swimming pool nestled in the privacy of the grounds, as well as a charming outbuilding. This annex includes a fully renovated one-bedroom apartment with its own private terrace, ideal for guests or rental income, and sits above a large garage. Part of the outbuilding remains to be restored, offering further potential.

A rare opportunity to own a piece of French heritage on the banks of the Garonne, just 30 minutes from Bordeaux.
