

You arrive at the property via a small driveway that runs alongside the house, leading past a large barn positioned to the right. Adjacent to the barn is a characterful old outbuilding—once a house—that could be converted into a gîte, subject to the necessary planning permissions. This potential guest accommodation can be accessed either from the driveway or directly through the barn.

Entry to the main house is through a charming courtyard garden, richly planted with flowers and mature shrubs. From here, you can also access the barn and two smaller outbuildings, ideal for use as a wood store or wine cellar.

Inside, the lounge (21m²) welcomes you with a cozy log-burning stove. This flows into the dining room, which also features a second stove and a staircase leading to the first floor. The kitchen (20.5m²) sits at the rear of the house, bright and well-equipped with a range of fitted units, and opens onto a spacious covered terrace—perfect for outdoor dining and relaxation.

The ground floor offers four bedrooms. Three are approximately I Im² each, and one is slightly smaller at 8m². Each has its own en-suite: three with shower rooms, and one with a bathroom. From inside the house, there is also direct access to the vast attached barn, which offers approximately 400m² of additional space—ideal for storage, hobbies, or future development.

Upstairs, two more bedrooms have been created within the eaves, accompanied by a family bathroom and a dressing room.
