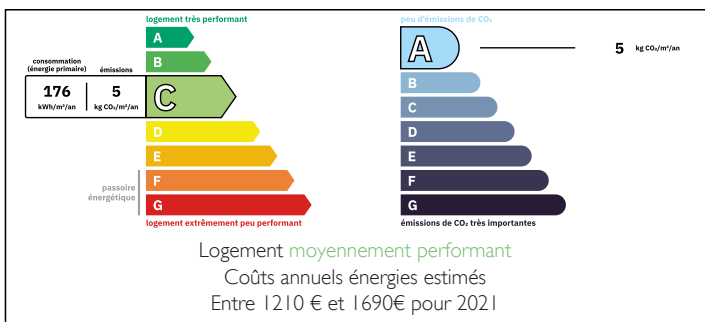

In the south of the Drôme Provençale, between Mont Ventoux and the Montagne de Lure, where time seems to stand still.

This house is perched on the heights of the village, accessible via a south-facing terrace equipped with a bioclimatic pergola. The living room, with its pellet stove, is perfect for cosy evenings, while the spacious Provençal-style kitchen naturally extends the living area. A ground-floor bedroom and a small shower room complete this practical and welcoming level.

Upstairs, a large mezzanine with a skylight—ideal as a study, workshop, or third bedroom—overlooks the heart of the home. A wide hallway with built-in storage leads to a second bedroom, a shower room, separate toilets, and best of all, a small, intimate garden hidden from view. A perfect spot for reading, gardening, enjoying a coffee—or simply doing nothing at all.

Comfort features include efficient heating (pellet stove and recent electric radiators), up-to-standard electrical systems, and high-quality insulation. Move-in ready, with nothing to renovate.

Shops and services are just 15 minutes away in Séderon, or 25 minutes in Montbrun-les-Bains, renowned for its thermal baths and lively markets.
