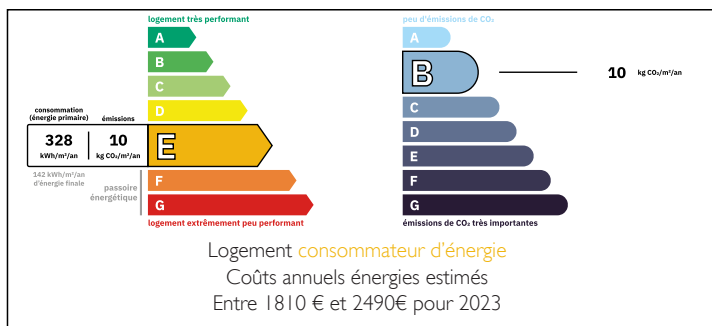


IN BRIEF

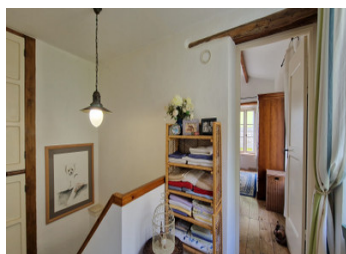
The village is 5 km from Olonzac, where there is a weekly market and all the amenities of a small market town.

DESCRIPTION

The house is much admired by passers-by, as it is so pretty, and you can sit outside on the little terrace with the wrought-iron chairs and flowers! The glazed front door gives access into the 16.6m² living room, with exposed ceiling joists, two windows, and a fireplace containing a gas-fired heater.

A stone step up leads to the stair hall, and into the 14m² kitchen with its cream-coloured doors, large gas cooker, terracotta coloured tiles and exposed ceiling joists. There is a cupboard under the stairs, a pantry, and room for a good-sized dining table.

Climbing the timber staircase with a first step in stone, there are two cupboards for storage. A pretty 5.4m² landing gives access to the two double bedrooms. All this floor has timber floorboards. The main bedroom of 13.7m² has an en-suite shower room of 3.8m² and two large wardrobes. It has three windows.

The second bedroom is 14.5m² and has a shower room of approx 3m². The two shower rooms have extractors and heated towel rails.

The heating in the house is electric in every room, plus the gas heater in the living area. About half the windows are double-glazed. Most of the furniture and white goods are available to buy with the house.

The village has a café/bar/restaurant, a tapas and wine bar, a grocery shop and a library, and is 5 km from other amenities in Olonzac. It is 32 km from Carcassonne, 34 km from Narbonne, 40 km...
