Inside, the ground floor features two large open rooms that can be reconfigured however you like, with enough space for a kitchen, living room, or even a ground-floor bedroom. Upstairs, there are three defined bedrooms as well as a fourth room that could easily become an office, guest room, or additional bathroom since the plumbing runs just below.

Outside, a private terrace leads onto a manageable garden, offering a peaceful outdoor space to enjoy in the warmer months.
