



Step through a double-glazed entrance that preserves the original sculpted hardwood doors and enter a striking central hallway, framed by a stone arch and original frescos with traditional cement tile flooring. To one side, a future dining room; to the other, a kitchen space ready to complete. Beyond, two stunning reception rooms—one with exquisite ceiling murals—both boasting panoramic countryside views. A guest cloakroom adds convenience on this level.

The main staircase leads either down through the workshop and into the garden, or up to two spacious upper floors. The first floor offers four bedrooms and three stylish shower rooms, while the second floor unveils a breathtaking, light-filled open-beam loft beneath a new, fully insulated roof.

Double glazing throughout, full rewiring, and discreetly installed smart lighting switches maintain both comfort and the integrity of this exceptional home's historic details.
