

The entrance hall leads to a bright and spacious sitting room to the left, and a separate dining room to the right. The fitted kitchen is beyond the dining room, and from there is a useful boot room with back door to the gardens and a separate toilet.

On the first floor, there are three large bedrooms, a laundry room, a bathroom, shower room and a separate toilet.

The second floor has three further bedrooms, a washroom, and attic space for storage.

Outside, the outbuildings are sensational, the largest skirting the peaceful village road outside, and the others reminding of bygone days with a former porcherie and bread oven. The in-ground swimming pool benefits from full sun and, past this and the pool house, there is a swathe of shady woodland and acres of pasture land that eventually borders the River Vauvre.

It has endless potential, niched in the picturesque village of Sarzay, with its restaurant, bar/tabac, historic 14th century château, and even a route de compostelle passing through.
