Brimming with charm and original features: exposed beams, solid wood floors, and preserved period details. Major structural work has been completed since 2023 with full approval from Bâtiments de France, including a new roof, double-glazed wooden windows, and sandblasted, treated, and reinforced beams.

A blank canvas ready to fit out – ideal as a family home, holiday property, or four individual rental units.

The 1st, 2nd, and 3rd floors each offer approx. 34 m² of floor area, with approx. 26 m² of habitable space on the 4th floor.
