Set behind its lovely arched porchway gates, this gorgeous property is situated in the heart of a village and close to shops in the market towns of Ruffec and Mansle - approx. 10 minutes to each.

With 3-bedrooms (one downstairs with an ensuite), a courtyard and a larger walled garden to the rear, this property is a real find!

DESCRIPTION

The lovely stone property is accessed via a large traditional, Charentaise porchway, which takes you into a pretty, private courtyard, which the property looks over on two sides.

The house itself has a lovely feel with large spacious rooms on the ground floor, high ceilings and lots of light. There is a large kitchen with a staircase up to the first floor, a pantry, wine cellar, a large living/dining room with a large feature fireplace and double patio doors and a study area. There is also a WC, a large bedroom with two large windows overlooking the courtyard, and an ensuite bathroom (with access to the separate WC).

On the first floor, there is a large double bedroom with dressing room, a further bedroom (with sloped ceiling) and a room with sink and WC. There is also an attic.

Outside, barn doors take you through to a large walled garden with a small outbuilding and a garage. Land size totals 1862m². To the front, there is another small outbuilding and a store room.

The property is habitable but some refreshment work would be welcome (double-glazing, insulation etc). There is currently no heating but there are radiators in place allowing a future buyer to choose the type of heating system they wish.
