

DESCRIPTION

The impressive entrance to the property is via electric gates, the gravel drive leads you to the house and ample parking. There are two grand entrances to the house but the most impressive leads you into a large reception area of over 100 m2 with a monumental fire place and views out over the grounds and down to the lake. The ground floor also boasts two bedrooms, two bathrooms, dining room and kitchen making a feature of its original bread oven, laundry room and toilet.

The large mezzanine floor currently used as a billiard room and lounge area also gives access to a further bedroom, bathroom and toilet. There is ample space to expand the living area if necessary.

The large impressive terrace has stunning views over the gardens, lake, swimming pool and the beautifully restored dovecote. The heated swimming pool is 12 x 6.5 meters, has a diving board, electronic cover and surrounded by a large patio. The quick-drying tennis court is an incredible addition to this property but it does require some restoration. Beyond the lake there is a small bridge over the river leading you to a stunning wooded area and many place to sit in the shade and enjoy the peace and tranquillity that this property has to offer.

This property is a rare find and in an absolutely stunning location, early viewings are recommended. All measurements are approximate.
