

DESCRIPTION

A small conservatory, currently used as a practical space for coats and shoes, leads to the main entrance of the house. Inside, the open-plan living area features a newly installed kitchen, a dining space, and a cosy lounge.

All on one level, the property offers two generously sized bedrooms, a stylishly designed shower room, a separate toilet, and a convenient storage cupboard.

Double-glazed windows with integrated fly screens allow for breathtaking views from the lounge, dining area, and main bedroom.

An internal staircase leads down to the basement, which is divided into three functional spaces, including an area suitable for parking a car.

The grounds of this property are fully fenced with a side driveway, a fabulous terrace for outside enjoyment and a lower garden, where the current owners keep chickens (this could also be a great vegetable patch).

The property is heated via new electric radiators.
