

DESCRIPTION

In the house, a bright entrance hall leads to a fitted kitchen-diner, a living-dining room with fireplace overlooking the garden, a bedroom, a study, a bathroom and a toilet. An outdoor terrace surrounds the first floor.

Upstairs, a mezzanine landing gives access to two bedrooms, a shower room with toilet and a beautiful room that could be used as an office or games room. A miller's ladder leads to the attic, which offers a storage space.

The basement includes a garage, workshop, boiler/laundry room and storage space.

This traditionally-built home, with its high-quality materials and meticulous decoration, benefits from insulated walls, double-glazed aluminum/wood windows and attic insulation. Heating is provided by a heat pump, an oil-fired boiler and a wood-burning insert. Hot water is supplied by an oil-fired boiler and a hot water tank for the gîte.

The magnificent garden is planted with trees and ornamental plants, including a palm and a banana tree, and features a small spring- and runoff-fed pond with wooden pontoon and water lilies, an orchard, a vegetable garden and a wood shed. The gravel courtyard features a carport near the entrance gate.

The gîte is accessed via a separate entrance and has its own parking space. There's a lovely living room with open-plan kitchen and cathedral ceiling, a bedroom with en-suite shower room and another bedroom with en-suite bathroom. Upstairs is a bedroom with a shower/washbasin/toilet area.
