

Fantastic potential to create a town house style dwelling in the centre of an historic village

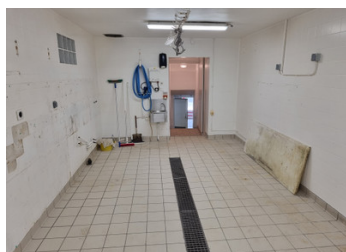

## IN BRIEF

With the recent retirement of the village butcher, this property is now available for someone else to transform it into either another business, or into a unique home. Located in between another house and the Heritage Museum in the centre of Lesterps, this building offers potential on every level. The ground floor is spacious, beginning with the former butcher's shop, flowing back into additional rooms behind the shop and the enormous garage area. The first floor offers a large, open-plan room with an old fireplace and old kitchen/ living area. The second floor offers two more rooms, plus an old shower room. There is also loft space above the second floor, plus a separate area above the garage. With some imagination and hard work this could be transformed into a very special property.

## DESCRIPTION

There is a front entrance directly into the former butcher's shop, and a rear entrance into the enormous garage area. From the front:

Ground floor

Former shop space of 18 m<sup>2</sup> in a rough square shape, with an additional 4 m<sup>2</sup> of an old cold storage room;

Behind this is another room of 8 m<sup>2</sup>, which then leads further back to the former meat storage and preparation area of 26 m<sup>2</sup>;

This leads finally to the garage, which is close to 100 m<sup>2</sup> with a ceiling height of 3.30 metres. The garage door appears to be tall and wide enough to accommodate a camping car. There is storage, a cloakroom, toilet and hand basin in between the front of the building and the garage, therefore connecting the two areas nicely.

First floor

A narrow staircase leads directly to a large room of around 33 m<sup>2</sup>. This room contains an old fireplace and kitchen area.

Second floor

There is one large room of 26 m<sup>2</sup>, plus a second room of 6 m<sup>2</sup> and then a shower room of 4 m<sup>2</sup>. Above this is an attic space of over 40 m<sup>2</sup>.

The property has no outside space, but is a very short walk to the communal park areas of the village.
