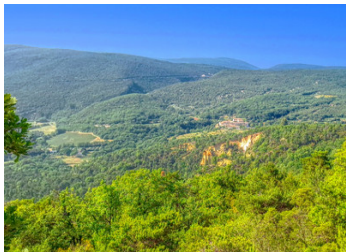


LUBERON, PROVENCE - Delightful Village Hideaway with Views and Character amidst nature

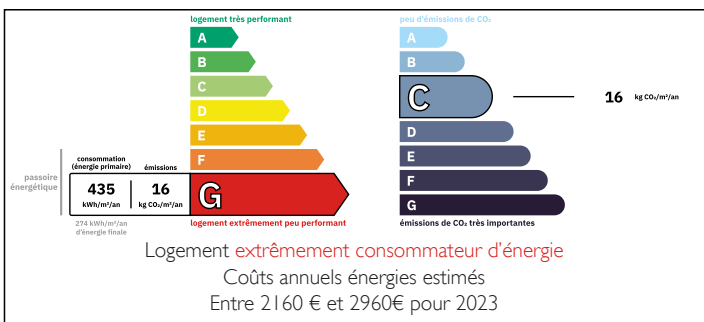
IN BRIEF

Tucked away in a peaceful Luberon village of around 100 inhabitants, this charming stone property is the perfect retreat for nature lovers and those seeking the essence of Provençal life. The house is spread over three levels, with its bright top floor (33 m²) accessible via an exterior stone staircase leading to a small village square. This sunny open-plan space—with kitchen, living area, mezzanine sleeping zone, and rooflights—offers lovely south-facing views over the surrounding mountains.

On the first floor, a separate bedroom, a shower room with shower and sink, and a laundry room with WC. The ground floor features a bakery workshop with a stunning old stone breadoven, still working!

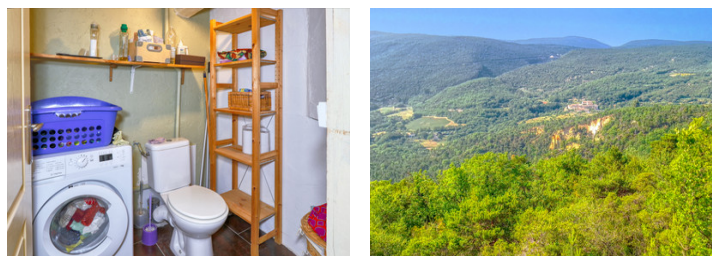
The village, though small, has all the hallmarks of authentic French living: a mairie, a lavoir, a pétanque pitch, a shady bench for village gossip, and a stunning
