

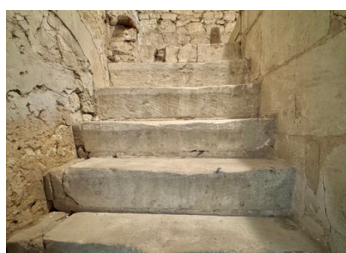

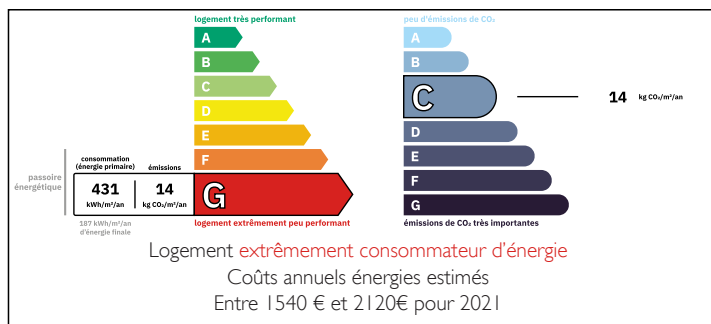
This charming little stone house is located in the heart of the historic town of Loudun and would be ideal as a pied-à-terre or investment property.

It is located on a one-way street with no through traffic, where you can only stop temporarily to unload your vehicle. There are four to five free parking spaces nearby.

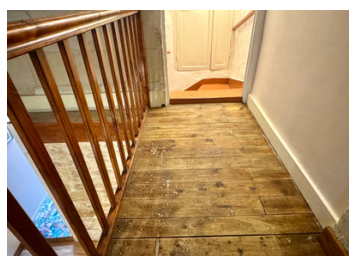
Thanks to its old features, such as stone corbels on the façade, two stone fireplaces, exposed stone walls, and a magnificent stone staircase leading to the attic, the house has a lot of character. The attic could be converted into a beautiful bedroom with a water supply.

PROPERTY DETAILS:

- The entrance leads into the living area, which is just over 20 m² and comprises a lounge/dining room with a fitted kitchen area, a beautiful stone fireplace and storage space under the stairs.
- A few steps lead to a 4.5 m² space that could be used as an office or storage room.
- To the left of this space is a 4 m² shower room with toilet, and in front of the few steps is the door leading to the terrace and garden, which is approximately 35 m² and features a beautiful bayleave tree.
- A stone staircase, covered by wood, leads to the 15 m² mezzanine sleeping area with a magnificent fireplace.
- A beautiful 26.5 m² attic completes this property, currently accessed via a ladder and then a beautiful stone staircase. With a little work, this space could be converted into a beautiful bedroom with a shower room.

TECHNICAL POINTS:

- The property is sold furnished as it is.
- Double glazing, except the main door.
 - Mains drainage
 - Electric radiator heating
 - The G energy rating can easily be improved by installing a new front door, insulating the attic (which would bring it up to E) and adding a pellet stove, which would bring it up to D.

THE REGION:

Restaurants and shops are just a few steps from the house and the town offers all possible services, including a media library, swimming pool, small cinema and hospital.
