

Shops, schools, and spa facilities are nearby, with Montluçon just 25 km and Guéret 45 km away.

## DESCRIPTION

Located in a quiet rural setting just outside Chambon-sur-Voueize, officially listed as one of the Plus Beaux Villages de France, this 1911 farmhouse offers character, space, and great potential. With 132 m<sup>2</sup> of living space and multiple outbuildings, it is ideal for a renovation project or small farming activity.

On the ground floor, the house includes a kitchen, a living room with fireplace, a separate dining room with wood-burning insert, a shower room with WC, and a utility/laundry room. The first floor offers four bedrooms, a family bathroom, and access to a convertible attic, providing potential for additional living space.

The property comes with a range of outbuildings, including:

A barn

Three stables – perfect for livestock or equestrian use

A 35 m<sup>2</sup> garage

Two additional stone outbuildings, offering storage or workshop space

The house sits on 2 hectares of adjoining land, ideal for gardening, animals, or leisure use.

Basic amenities (shops, cafés, school, etc.) are nearby in Chambon-sur-Voueize, while Evaux-les-Bains, a charming thermal spa town, is just a short drive away. The larger towns of Montluçon (25 km) and Guéret (45 km) provide supermarkets, hospitals, and all major services.
