## DESCRIPTION

Set back from a no-through lane, the property is hidden away.

#### House I - wood framed

You enter into a roomy open plan 22.4m2 kitchen/diner/living space. Off here you find three bedrooms of 13.6, 13.8 and 7.5m2 as well as a 3.8m2 shower room. All the accommodation is on the ground floor with an attic area above. In the basement there is the oil fired central heating boiler. It provides useful storage and covers the footprint of the house.

#### Outside.

There is a garage type structure to the side of the house as you approach it as well as another small stone outbuilding hidden in trees. There is a garden area to the rear of the house that leads out on to the land where you find some flat grazing and numerous fruit trees.

#### House 2 - in stone

This building is to renovate, but it has the potential to be a beautiful home. At present there is a a good sized room on the ground floor with a large attic space above. There is an old stable and lean^to to the side. Tucked away you would hardly know the building is there.

#### Outside.

This stone building could be separated from the other house. The grounds offer mature trees and the potential for a more formal garden as well as the grazing land that would be ideal for horses or other animals. All this in a rural hamlet setting.
