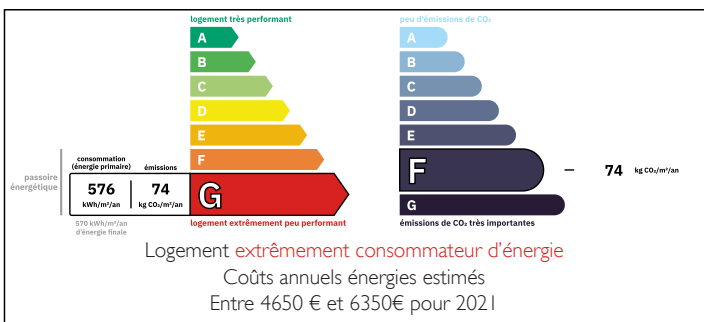
A remarkable renovation project to do in this very large property with 4 bedrooms and a very spacious ground floor encompassing a huge open kitchen/ diner.

DESCRIPTION

A stone house with a slate roof comprising-

On the ground floor:

An entrance hall, a large fitted kitchen with large open dining area. Stairs down to the basement, and up to the first floor and WC.

Access to the lounge is via the front entrance hall or via a separate lobby area next to the kitchen which has been partitioned to create an office space. In this lobby area there is an external door and staircase leading down to the garden.

The lounge is spacious, boasting dual aspect large windows, a fireplace with wood burner and plenty of space for entertaining.

Upstairs:

There are 4 good sized bedrooms and a bathroom including a bath with integrated shower. There is an additional smaller room on this floor which could be used to create a further en-suite or office space.

Outside:

There is a large garden with views of the imposing Château de Domfront ruins above. There is a large two-storey outbuilding, and to the left of this, the garden opens up and leads you down to a private grassy riverbank with mature trees.
