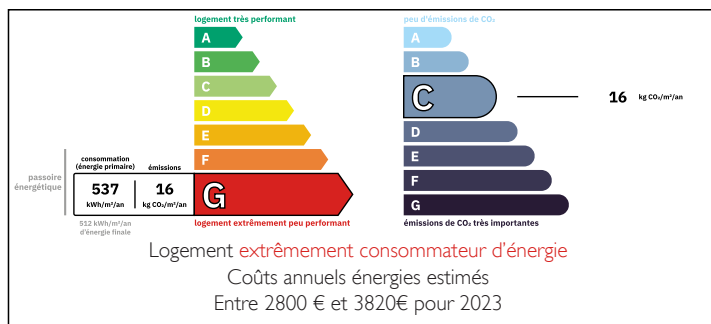

IN BRIEF

This very pretty farm that once belonged to the castle a field away, which could again be part of a lovely view by clearing some of the undergrowth. Although it has some modern washroom and sanitary appliances, the house needs interior updating and eventual reroofing. The farmyard beyond has two magnificent barns, one, oval which is likely to be 17th century, its roof structure is supported by two enormous oak cruck columns that curve up inside the walls to the ridge; it is of historical interest and one of a handful left in existence. A gem!
