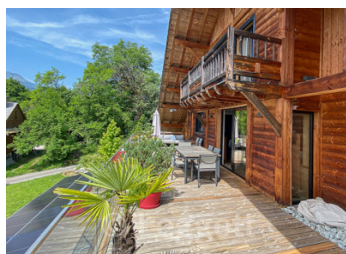

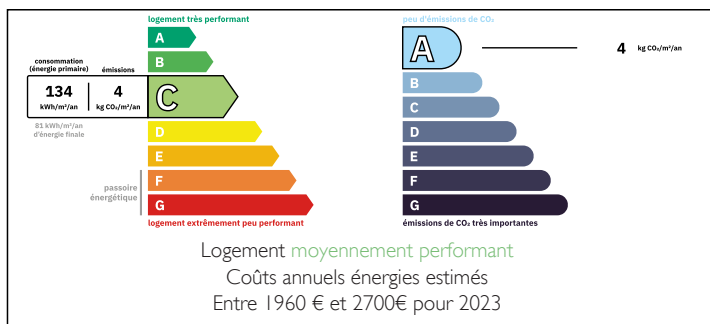

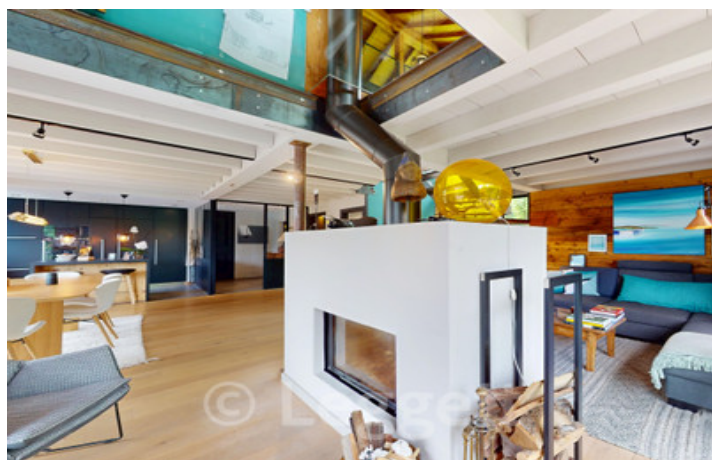

DESCRIPTION

This Douglas pine chalet combines sustainability, comfort, and versatility. Large windows fill the home with light and frame mountain views, while landscaped gardens feature terraces for year-round outdoor living, including one with solar panels and another with an electric awning. Eco-conscious design includes underfloor heating via a heat-exchange pump, solar energy, and an EV charging point. A jacuzzi adds a touch of luxury.

Spread across three levels, the property is divided into two independent accommodation spaces, offering strong rental potential, flexibility for multi-generational living, or guest accommodation in total privacy.

The principal residence in the chalet currently provides two bedrooms and a mezzanine, but its design allows for straightforward adaptation into a four-bedroom plus mezzanine home by transforming the office and upper lounge into extra bedrooms. In addition, there is scope to create an underground garage at the rear, with the present owner—an architect—willing to supervise the project if required.

MIEUSSY: A HIDDEN GEM IN THE HAUTE-SAVOIE

Mieussy is famously the birthplace of modern paragliding, with the first successful recreational flights taking place at Pointe du Pertuiset in 1978. This achievement attracts paragliding enthusiasts from around the world.

The village itself is home to the 17th-century Church of Saint-Gervais-et-Saint-Prottais, a peaceful spot showcasing traditional Savoyard architecture. Visitors can enjoy authentic Alpine cuisine at local restaurants, as well as explore local farms that offer fresh cheeses like Reblochon and traditional Savoyard products.
