

Entering through a beautiful, authentic hallway with an arched doorway and stone flooring, you are welcomed into the grand living area, a bright and airy space featuring exposed beams and an open fireplace. The kitchen, a real highlight, spans 17 m² and opens into a 25 m² dining area with a wood-burning fire.

A formal dining room (25 m²) with wood flooring and a games room with pool table provide further entertainment spaces.

The ground-floor bedroom (23 m²) features exposed beams, a roll-top bath, and a private bathroom, with access to the front terrace.

The Manoir is divided into two wings. The left wing first floor offers three spacious bedrooms (22–35 m²), each with en-suite or private bathrooms.

The right wing provides a large 14 m² bathroom, a 15.5 m² bedroom, and a small office/storage room. A cosy seating area (35 m²) with mezzanine-level additional seating and two further bedrooms (one with en-suite) completes the interior spaces.

Attached to the main house is a 150 m² barn, perfect for storage or entertainment. A fabulous covered terrace offers an ideal setting for outside dining and events. The grounds include a large garden, an inground swimming pool with its own terrace, an orchard, a stable block, and woodland, all part of 4.1 ha of land.
