

## DESCRIPTION

The ground floor has two doors leading to two sides of a large space.

On one side is a study with a sofa bed, on the other a hallway and boot room with toilet and stairway to the middle floor. The small door on the ground floor could be a private entrance for a second en-suite bedroom. Room size is more than 13m2.

The middle floor is one large, bright room, (roughly 30 m2), with fireplace and wood burner. There is a corner kitchen, sitting and dining areas. The top floor is also light and airy, (also 30 m2), with built in wardrobe, sitting area and adjoining bathroom. All floors are either oak or French tiles. This house is economical, easy to run and oozing with charm.

The front leads on to a pedestrian village lane and the garden is about 20 metres down the lane and looks out to open country side. The separate garden is about 150sq m. There is parking for two vehicles near the garden.
