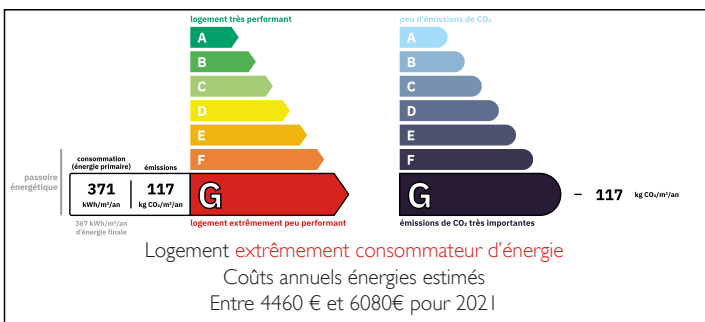

DESCRIPTION

The chalet offers four double bedrooms across two levels, with bright living and dining spaces opening onto a covered terrace and wrap-around balcony. The garden level includes an additional living room, ski room, laundry, and storage areas.

Outside, the property benefits from a long private driveway with parking, a garden, and a traditional mazot/wooden outbuilding.

The village of Samoëns provides access to France's fourth largest ski area, the Grand Massif (which includes Flaine, Morillon and Les Carroz) and its 265km of pistes. As Geneva airport is just one hour away by car approximately, the apartment has excellent rental potential as well as making a lovely second home.

Samoëns is a beautiful traditional village, steeped in history. It's just as popular from spring to autumn with activities for all ages, including very accessible world-class hiking opportunities, outdoor swimming pools and lakes, rafting, paragliding, mountain biking, road cycling, canyoning and so much more.
