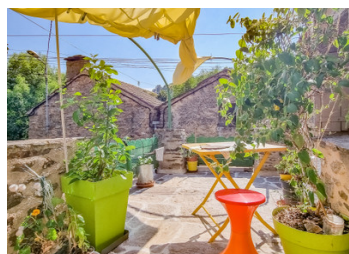


Charming stone house with terrace in a picturesque hamlet of St Vincent d'Olargues

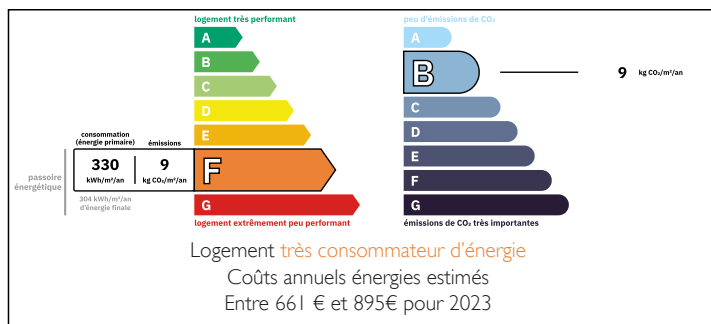

IN BRIEF

Located in a picturesque hamlet of St Vincent d'Olargues, this 41 m² stone house charms with its authenticity and welcoming atmosphere. From the moment you step inside, the appeal is evident with a superb stone-vaulted room on the ground floor, perfect as a sitting room. Upstairs, a bright living area opens onto a lovely 11 m² terrace, ideal for outdoor dining. A mezzanine, currently used as a bedroom, overlooks the living space and adds to the property's distinctive and convivial character.

The house is equipped with double-glazed windows, a fireplace insert, and mains drainage. Some modernisation work, particularly to the shower room and kitchenette, would allow you to personalise the property and unlock its full potential. DESCRIPTION

The house offers approximately 41 m² of habitable space:

Ground floor: a 24 m² room with stone vaulted ceiling, shower room with shower, WC, washbasin and recent hot water tank.

First floor: 15 m² living room with kitchenette, separate WC with washbasin, and access to an 11 m² stone terrace with no direct overlooking.

Mezzanine: approximately 7 m² floor space, currently used as a bedroom.
