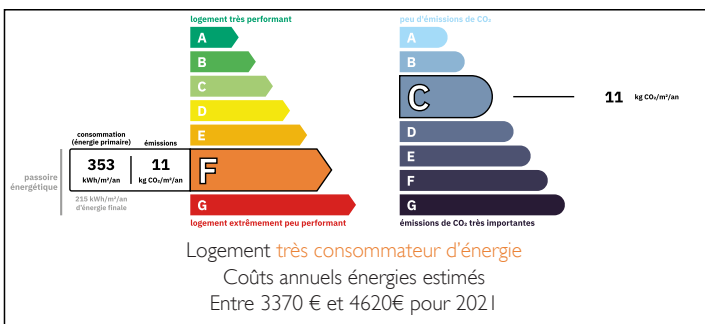

DESCRIPTION

Located in the picturesque village of Lannes (16230), in the Charente department, this traditional stone house offers comfortable living spread across three floors. The property comprises:
Ground floor: living room and kitchen.

First floor: two bedrooms, shower room with WC, landing.

Second floor: bedroom with en suite bathroom and WC.

Externally, the property includes two sizeable stone-built outbuildings, a private garden, and a courtyard — offering scope for storage, renovation, or additional living space.

Lannes is a charming village with nearby amenities set in a peaceful rural setting yet well-connected to surrounding towns and cities : Ruffec 14 km and Mansle 10 km the local market towns, both with supermarkets, schools, access to the Charente River, bars and restaurants and a local Hospital in Ruffec, Angoulême, the department's main city, lies about 40 km away, offering a wide range of services, cultural attractions, and shopping facilities. Cognac is around 45 km, and Périgueux approximately 50 km. For transport, the property benefits from easy access to the D939 and D737 roads, connecting to the A10 motorway. Angoulême – Brie Champniers Airport is just 35 km away, with larger airports in Bordeaux (140 km) and Limoges (90 km) providing both domestic and international flights.

This property offers a rare opportunity to own a traditional Charentais home with character, scope, and excellent connectivity to both local and regional hubs.
