

Entrance hall around 11.5m2 with staircase, large lounge with fireplace around 30m2, second cosy lounge with fireplace 17m2, reception room over 20m2, dining room with fireplace (ideal for creating a large kitchen/diner) 30m2, kitchen 6m2, wc.

Large attached garage/workshop over 50m2.

Gas central heating (recent boiler), double glazing for most windows, mains drainage. Perfectly habitable, would benefit from some updating.
