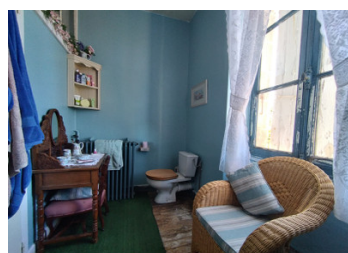
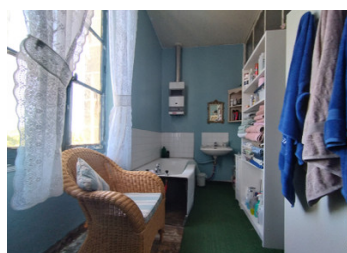

DESCRIPTION

The current owners have undertaken extensive renovations on this beautiful home, including new electrical and plumbing systems, and work will continue until the property is sold. (A detailed list of completed and ongoing works is available upon request.)

This is a rare opportunity for any family to own a home rich in character and history.

Set on a quiet road near the village, the property welcomes you with an impressive hallway that runs from front to back, providing access to four ground floor rooms.

To the left, you'll find the dining room, featuring high ceilings and original windows, which flows through to a kitchen equipped with plumbing for both a washing machine and dishwasher.

On the right is the lounge, complete with a fireplace, while the fourth room on the ground floor is set to become a brand-new bathroom.

The original staircase leads to the first floor, where a long hallway provides access to four rooms. On the left are two generously sized double bedrooms, one of which is currently used as an elegant dressing room.

To the right, the front-facing room serves as another spacious double bedroom, while the rear room is a smaller double guest bedroom featuring its own ensuite bathroom. High ceilings, wooden floors, and original windows add charm and character to the home.

A further staircase leads to the attic, which offers potential for conversion into an additional master bedroom with ensuite bathroom, if desired.
