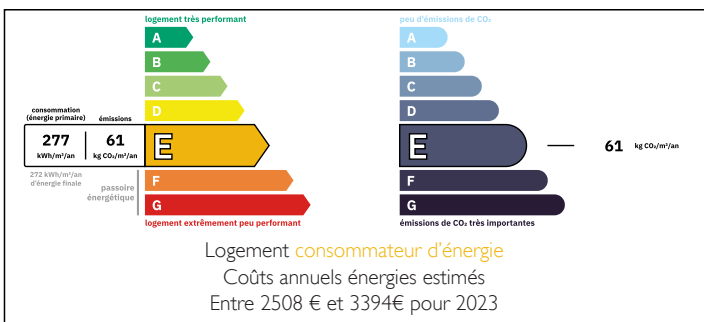
IN BRIEF

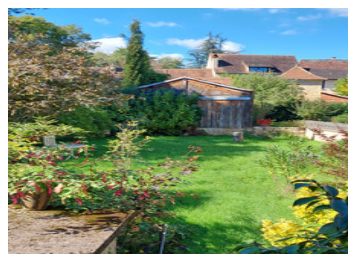
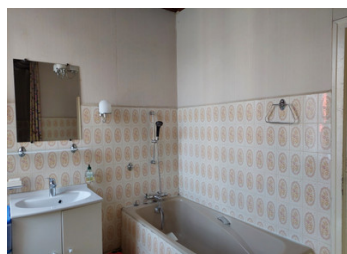

DESCRIPTION

Stone house, located close to Lalinde - a beautiful bastide town of Périgord Pourpre with all necessary shops and amenities, as well as a railway station and a weekly market.

The property is at the old center/bourg of a pretty village, close to a château and not far from the river Dordogne. The area is calm, but not isolated. Different sport and leisure activities are available nearby.

The house

The house consists of two levels, with a total habitable surface of approximately 107 m², 5 rooms/ of which 2 bedrooms, 1 office room, salon, living room/, bathroom, kitchen and 2 WC.

The ground floor offers a large living area, suitable for comfortable everyday living and entertaining. The separate kitchen provides scope for reconfiguration to suit modern living.

Upstairs, the bedrooms are well-proportioned, making the house suitable for family use or hosting guests. The layout is practical and easy to live in.

The attic space, currently unused, offers additional potential for conversion into an office, extra bedroom or hobby room, subject to the necessary permissions.

The property is connected to the mains. There is a central gas heating.
