

As soon as you enter, with its Belgian black marble and Saumur stone, you will be charmed by the character of the place. The vast 31.9 m² living room, bathed in light, features rare lemonwood and Madagascan violet wood parquet flooring, reflecting the owner's cabinetmaking skills. A 32.3 m² dining room and an 18.3 m² kitchen complete this reception area.

Spread over three levels, the house has four large bedrooms ranging from 18 m² to 27 m², each with its own shower room or bathroom.

The south-facing rear façade provides plenty of light and opens onto the tree-lined garden.
