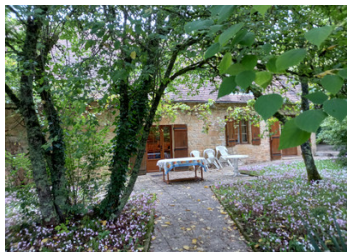


5 bedroomed stone house, in a quiet hillside hamlet, 2 garages, garden and pool



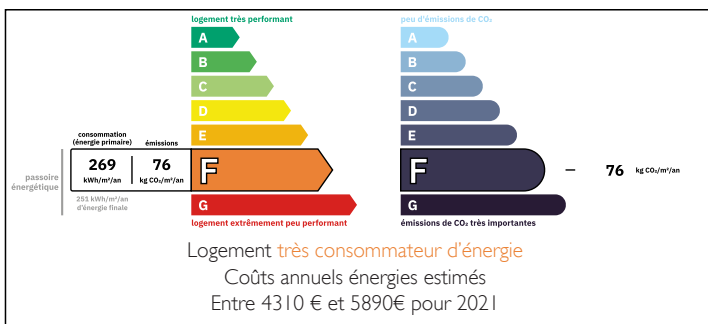

## IN BRIEF

Stone property of 140m2 with a large sitting/dining room (40m2) featuring a period fireplace and exposed beams. There is a fitted kitchen (15m2) and a bath/shower room, sink and toilet (8m2). Upstairs are 5 bedrooms, an office area/ a tv area, 1 box room, a shower room and separate WC. Set in a garden of 1028m2 with a swimming pool and a covered terrace (15m2). The house is in good general condition. The property has a swimming pool 6m x3m, two garages and is currently rented as a holiday let for 1200 euros a week. It has a period fireplace with a log burner and oil central heating. There is wine cellar located in one of the garages.

## DESCRIPTION

This stone property has many period features and is located in a hamlet on the top of a hill with countryside views. Enter into the fitted kitchen (15.5m<sup>2</sup>) which leads into the sitting/dining room (40m<sup>2</sup>) which has a magnificent period fireplace currently equipped with a log burner and exposed beams. A hall leads off the kitchen (15m<sup>2</sup>) to a downstairs shower/bath room and toilet (8m<sup>2</sup>) and access to one of the garages which has a metal grill leading down to a cave or wine cellar. Stairs from the hall lead up to the 5 upstairs bedrooms (12m<sup>2</sup>, 10m<sup>2</sup>, 12m<sup>2</sup>, 9.5m<sup>2</sup>, 6m<sup>2</sup>) There is an office area and or tv area 7m<sup>2</sup>, with velux windows. There is a second upstairs shower room and toilet (3m<sup>2</sup>) and a separate WC (1.6m<sup>2</sup>).

Outside, there is a large, covered terrace (15m<sup>2</sup>) on the side of the house and a fenced garden of 1028m<sup>2</sup> featuring a swimming pool of 6mx3m. There is a second garage located a few meters away from the house.
