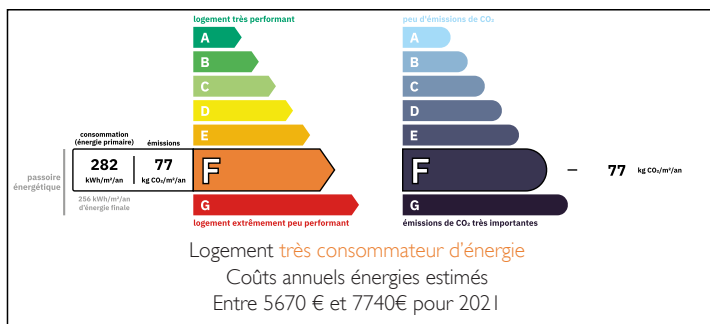

Located in the Parc Naturel Régional du Vexin Français, just 45 minutes from Paris, this historic 17th-century property offers a true retreat in the heart of nature. The main house, with a total surface of 372 m² (of which 266 m² are habitable), impresses with its generous volumes and authentic character. The landscaped and wooded estate of nearly 5,000 m² also includes four independent dwellings measuring 70 m² (2 bedrooms), 63 m² (2 bedrooms), 60 m² (1 bedroom) and 35 m² (studio) — perfect for hosting guests, creating holiday rentals or developing a B&B activity. Three houses are currently rented, generating €2,700 per month (one recent lease, with room for adjustment). Detailed Description

Main House (266.96 m² habitable – 372.57 m² total)
Built in the 17th century, the main residence embodies the authentic charm of the Vexin heritage. It is arranged over three spacious levels:

Basement: hallway, boiler room, wine cellar.

Ground floor: entrance, kitchen, dining room, living room, WC, laundry room, hallway, veranda opening onto the garden.

First floor: landing, three bedrooms, bathroom, shower room, washroom, convertible attic space.

Second floor: three additional bedrooms, landings, washroom, attic.

The house benefits from beautiful light, high ceilings, and central oil-fired heating ensuring comfort and even temperature.

Guest House (70 m² – 2 bedrooms)

Fully renovated, it offers on the ground floor a bright living area with open kitchen, and on the upper floor two bedrooms and a shower room.

Perfect for family accommodation or short-term rental.

Parking-Side House (63 m² – 2 bedrooms)

Accessible from the main courtyard, it includes on the ground floor a living room with kitchen and shower room, and upstairs two comfortable bedrooms.

Ideal for staff housing or independent rental income.

Garden House (60 m² – 1 bedroom)

Single-storey dwelling featuring a through living area with kitchen, one bedroom, and a shower room.

Well-designed layout, functional and pleasant setting.

Independent Studio on Terrace (35 m²)

Compact, fully equipped accommodation comprising a main room, kitchen area, and shower room with WC.
