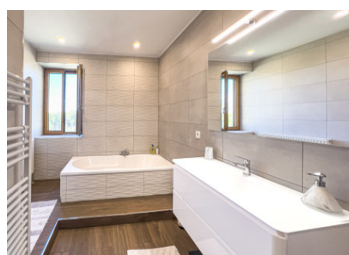
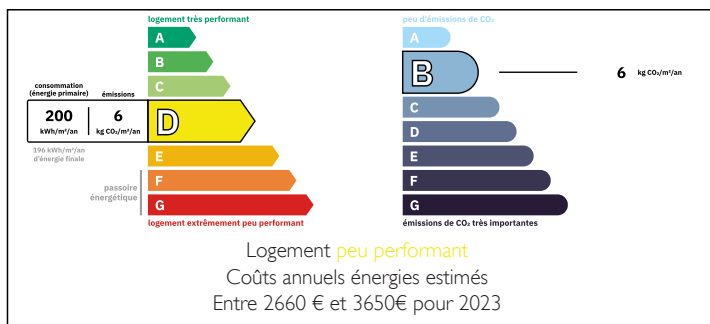


Near Duras & Eymet – character stone home with spacious independent gîte, pool, 1 ha and panoramic views

IN BRIEF

In a peaceful countryside setting near Duras and Eymet, this beautifully restored stone home enjoys an elevated position with far-reaching views towards a distant hilltop village. Calm and private, it combines character, comfort and generous outdoor living.

Light-filled living spaces open onto a spacious wrap-around terrace, while the 3-bedroom main house includes a generous kitchen-dining room, inviting living room with pellet stove, second reception and principal suite. Across the charming courtyard, a substantial independent gîte provides flexible accommodation for family, guests or holiday letting.

Around 1 ha of landscaped grounds includes mature gardens, a 10 × 5 m swimming pool and a well, while more than 250 m² of outbuildings provide excellent garage, workshop and storage space. A 2022 pellet boiler adds efficient modern heating to

DESCRIPTION

Set in peaceful countryside near Duras and Eymet, this beautifully restored stone property enjoys an elevated position with far-reaching views towards a distant hilltop village. Private without being isolated, it combines character, comfortable year-round living and generous outdoor space.

The main house is light and welcoming, with exposed stone, beams and tiled floors. A spacious kitchen-dining room and double-aspect living room with pellet stove connect easily with the wrap-around terrace, ideal for outdoor dining and relaxing. A second reception area, open to the living room, works well as a study or snug.

Upstairs, the principal bedroom has a dressing area and en-suite shower room, alongside two further double bedrooms and a family bathroom. An efficient wood-pellet boiler installed in 2022 provides central heating.

Across the flower-filled courtyard, the converted dovecote provides a substantial independent gîte with a generous open-plan kitchen/living space, pellet stove, ground-floor bedroom and shower room, plus a windowed mezzanine sleeping area in the tower.

Over 250 m² of outbuildings include a large utility room, garage, workshop and generous storage. The owners hold a professional quote for full or partial removal of the large barn but have deliberately left the work undone, preferring to give a future buyer the choice of how best to use the space — whether retaining more of the building or opening it up to create a sheltered walled garden, subject to any necessary permissions.

The landscaped grounds extend to around 1 hectare, with mature trees, a well and a 10 × 5...
