



Despite its rural feel, the property is conveniently located less than 4km from the pretty town of Aunac-sur- Charente which has a Doctors surgery, Pharmacy, Grocery shop and a bar restaurant. 7 km from the town of Mansle with restaurants, bar, supermarket Doctors and Vets and approx. I5km from the larger market town of Ruffec with all amenities including school, college etc...
