Charming Two-Bedroom Home in the Heart of Brigueil-le-Chantre

Tucked away in the lovely village of Brigueil-le-Chantre, this sunny two-bedroom house is perfect as a first home or a peaceful holiday getaway.

Step through the side entrance into a cozy entrance hall space $(2.27m \times 2.08m)$ at the bottom of the stairs—perfect for hanging coats and leaving boots—complete with a quirky under-stairs toilet.

To your left, you'll find a bright, open-plan living area $(3.92 \text{m} \times 3.83 \text{m})$ with a fireplace (currently boarded up) and front-facing windows that let in plenty of light. The kitchen($3\text{m} \times 3.7\text{m}$) has some handy storage cupboards and steps leading out to a sunny south-facing terrace $(4.3\text{m} \times 7.2\text{m})$, ideal for enjoying morning coffee or evening sunsets while overlooking the rolling countryside.

Upstairs, the first bedroom (2.99m \times 3.26m) at the back of the house is currently used as an office, and the bathroom (1.54m \times 1.99m) is practical with a shower, toilet, and sink. The second bedroom (3.7m \times 4.56m) is generous in size, with windows looking out to the front of the house.

At the back, there's a garage $(4.3m \times 7.2m)$ that houses the water tank, along with a small adjacent cave $(2.89m \times 6.9m)$ for extra storage. Just a few steps down the path, you'll also find a detached garden (306 sq m) — although currently overgrown, this could be a lovely little outdoor space for your vegetable garden or just sitting and relaxing.
