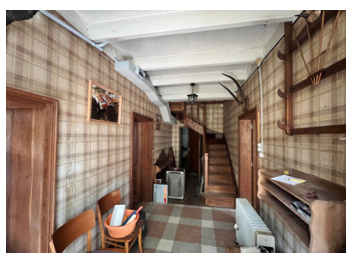


A Grand Renovation Project in the Peaceful Charente Countryside

The Main House
