

Location

In the heart of Occitanie, between the Mediterranean Sea and the Pyrenean mountains, Puichéric enjoys an ideal setting. The nearest beaches are less than an hour away, and the first ski resorts can be reached in around 2.5 hours. Carcassonne, its airport, and its UNESCO-listed Medieval Cité are only 30 minutes from the village. The airport offers direct flights to London, Dublin, Manchester, Brussels—Charleroi and Porto, providing easy access to major European hubs.

Nestled between Carcassonne and Narbonne, Puichéric is part of the Minervois region, known for its natural beauty and its vibrant network of local producers. Depending on the season, the surrounding landscape showcases vineyards, asparagus fields, apple orchards, table grapes, plums and a range of other high-quality local products — a true reflection of the region's rich terroir and strong tradition of short supply chains.

The village is also very convenient for everyday life, with essential shops and services on-site: a butcher, a bar, a restaurant, a bakery, a newsagent/tabac, a small grocery shop, a hairdresser and more.

Puichéric is often referred to as the Venice of the Minervois thanks to the three waterways that cross the village:

- the Canal du Midi, offering peaceful and picturesque scenery,
- the Rigole de l'Étang de Marseillette, winding through vineyards and village streets,
- the River Aude, perfect for canoeing, water activities, fishing, or...
