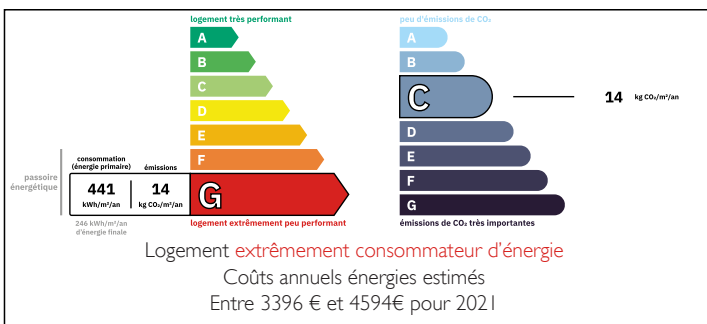

Charming country house in a quiet hamlet just a couple of kilometers from Arnac La Poste, offering great potential with some work to restore its former glory.

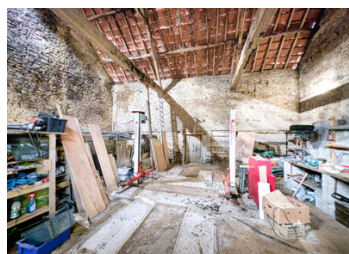
The basics are solid: a good insulated roof, double glazing, mains water and sewage, and fibre internet. The ground floor features a living room, dining room, and kitchen, with exposed oak beams and wonderful views over the back garden. A guest WC adds convenience.

Upstairs there are two spacious bedrooms and a smaller one used as an office, plus access to the attic for excellent storage.

The detached barn provides versatile space for workshops or storage, while a covered terrace area suits parking or an outdoor kitchen. Gardens boast beautiful countryside views too.
