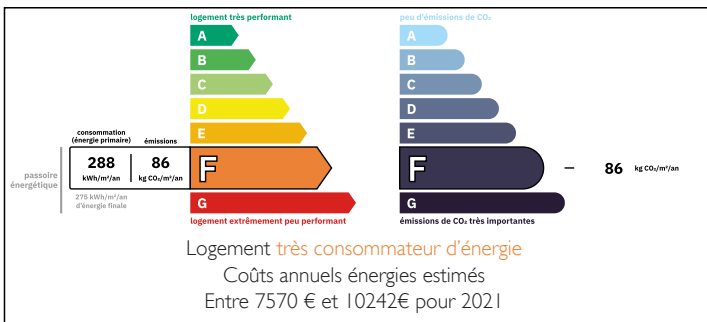


Opportunities abound with 2 interjoined houses plus shop

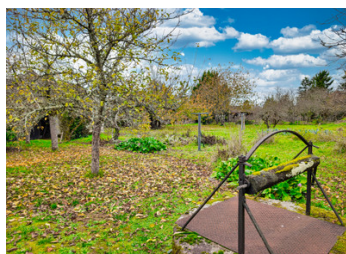
