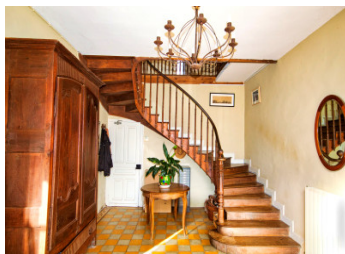

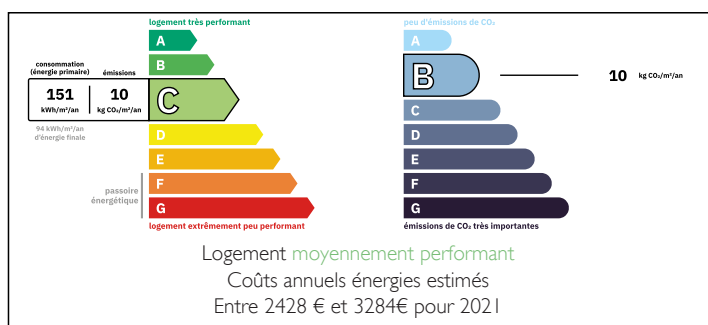

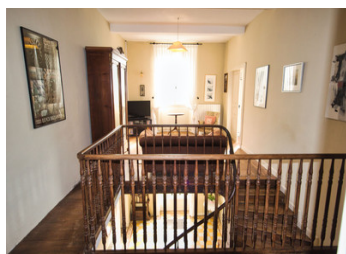

DESCRIPTION
