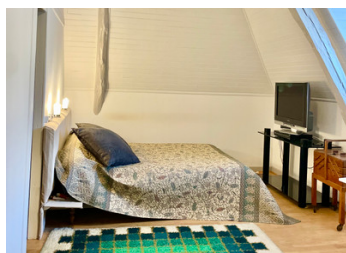

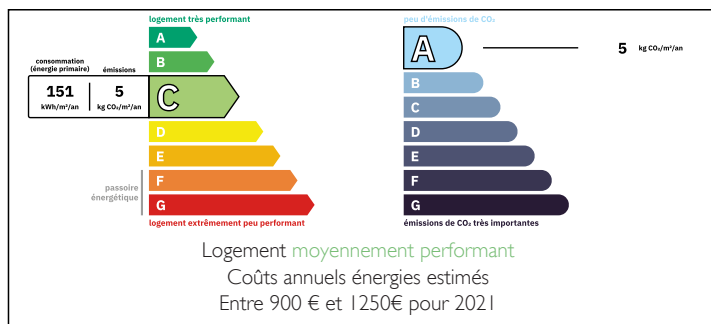

With around 112 m² of living space, four bright rooms and a large cellar with conversion potential, this home combines authentic charm with modern comfort.

The first floor offers a generous open-plan living area featuring a cozy sitting corner with fireplace, a bright workspace overlooking the stunning garden, and an elegant original door leading to a separate toilet and utility room. The other half of this level is designed as a spacious dining area with an open kitchen—perfect for cooking and entertaining. Directly connected to the living space, the large covered terrace allows you to enjoy outdoor dining and relaxation during most of the year.
