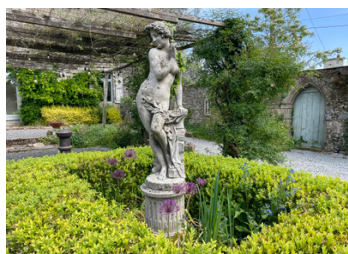

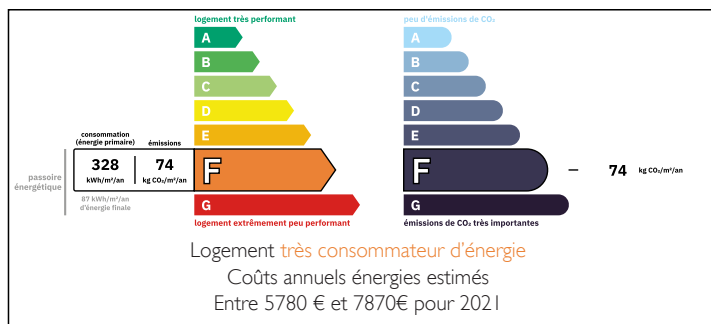

## DESCRIPTION

As you approach this charming French property, a gravelled parking area welcomes you and offers the first glimpse of its rich history. From here, you can see the private chapel—an atmospheric building in need of renovation, once used during the war for gatherings to keep village spirits high. To the left lies the private orchard, a peaceful haven with beautiful views across the surrounding countryside.

Passing through a characterful stone archway, you step into the delightful stone-walled courtyard. This enclosed space is bordered by two outbuildings: a generous barn ideal for storage or further development, and a second barn housing an ancient bread oven—an evocative reminder of the property's past.

The main house is entered through the spacious kitchen, a warm and welcoming room featuring a woodburner, standard appliances, and ample space for dining. From here, the original servant staircase leads to what once served as servants' quarters, now thoughtfully converted into bedrooms 4 and 5, along with a bathroom with bathtub. This staircase also provides access to the extensive attic.

A back door from the kitchen, sheltered by a porch, leads to the rear garden. The main entrance corridor offers a practical storage cupboard, boot rack, and coat area before opening into the formal lounge. This impressive room features a closed fireplace, double-aspect windows, patio doors to the rear garden, and a charming window seat overlooking the courtyard. Its generous proportions comfortably accommodate both a formal seating area and a dining space.
